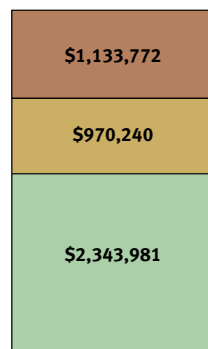
No other early education center in the City provides comprehensive and nationally-recognized services to so many working poor and homeless families.

It would be impossible without significant financial assistance from the Federal, State and Municipal governments, and we are particularly proud that each year we match every three dollars provided by public agencies with one dollar donated by individuals, foundations and corporations — one half million dollars each year.

Due to the generosity of our donors, approximately 131 of our 171 families received full or partial assistance at any given time last year. Parents/guardians who need partial or full scholarships receive assistance, including hard-working middle-income families, working poor families, and homeless families. Because economic self-sufficiency is a primary goal, all of our parents and guardians are either working or are in school full time. **Thank you for your generous support.**

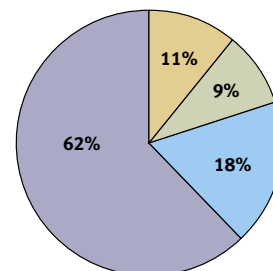
2008 Revenue by Source
