100 Years in the Mission

More than 16,000 Holy Family Day Home children and their families have received the opportunity and skills to maintain stable, healthy lives, realize their potential, and better contribute to their community. On February 12, 2011, our family gathered to celebrate our proud history of 100 Years in the Mission District.

The occasion illustrated how the community we serve has grown and changed in the last century—and how some things have stayed remarkably the same. San Francisco is still a diverse city with a mix of wealth and poverty, of opportunity and disadvantage, a city where thousands of families struggle to make ends meet in an often unforgiving economy. At the Day Home we remain committed to our tradition.

With roots in the City as far back as 1872, the Sisters of the Holy Family sheltered needy children and provided support for families, most notably in Golden Gate Park in tents after the great earthquake of 1906. With funding from Virginia "Birdie" Fair (later Vanderbilt), a beautiful facility opened in 1911 on the corner of 16th and Dolores streets for the continuation of our mission. Through the Great Depression and two world wars, the Sisters enriched the lives of young children.

In 1949 one of our treasured alums and a staunch supporter to this day, Teo Baumgardner became one of the Day Home's youngest charges. Teo remembers Sister Mary Agnes Gough playing the piano, the smell of Sloppy Joes from the Day Home's basement kitchen, and the child-friendly half-steps leading to the upper floors. But what she remembers most is the love and support she received from her teachers and caregivers. "My parents, Rose and Erwin Succetti were eternally grateful that I spent my youngest years surrounded by love and a feeling of absolute security."

San Francisco's last big earthquake in 1989 badly damaged

the original Day Home, which necessitated a major fundraising drive, spearheaded by the first lay director, Donna M. Cahill and her dedicated Board of Directors. In 2007 the doors of the new facility opened, welcoming 150 excited children and their families. We're proud to say that our facility rivals any private day care center in the City.

Board member Sister Gladys Guenther, Congregational President of the Sisters of the Holy Family, along with Sister Marianne Smith, who has worked at HFDH for over 20 years, have seen incredible change as well as the constant need to help families. Among the families of our 171 children: 20% come to us from the shelter system; 70% report incomes below \$25,000; and 30% are enrolled in welfare-to-work programs.

Your support, along with the gifts of other caring HFDH donors, is what makes our work possible. As we celebrate our 100th anniversary in the Mission this year, we want to thank you again for your kind and gracious support.

Fourteen years ago when I joined the Day Home family, I couldn't have imagined the joy I would feel on February 12, 2011 when we celebrated **100 Years in the Mission District** with you, our loyal friends and supporters. Everyday we bear witness to the arduous journeys that our children and parents embark upon-reflecting on their everyday struggles, assessing their progress, dreaming of a hopeful future, and coming up with a plan not just to survive, but to thrive.

You can be very proud of the resilience of Holy Family Day Home. There are many concrete signs that we are fiscally sound:

- Paid off nearly 50% of our construction loans in 2010 (to date raised \$6.8MM of our \$7.8MM new building construction costs)
- Met our fundraising goal & gave scholarships to 70% of our families
- Loyal foundations continued to lend their support
- Volunteer core remained strong



But by far the **most important accomplishments** were those of our educated, well prepared graduates and their now stable, healthy families who realize their potential and are able to contribute to their communities.

The challenge now is that for the last 6 months I have spent a good deal of time meeting with my colleagues and city officials advocating for low-income and homeless families whose lives will be turned up side down by the inevitable state budget cuts to childcare. Unfortunately, Holy Family Day Home will be affected by the cuts. We know that many families' support will be cut or reduced, so it suffices to say that we will need your support more than ever.

Therefore, we invite you to continue your support at whatever level possible to our **Embrace-A-Child Scholarship Fund** (\$5,000 supports one child and their family for one full year), **and to lend a warm helping hand.** We eagerly welcome volunteers for the 2012 Coming Home Gala, the Farmer's Market, for music and art classroom assistance, and field trip resources such as buses, tickets for children's musicals and museums.

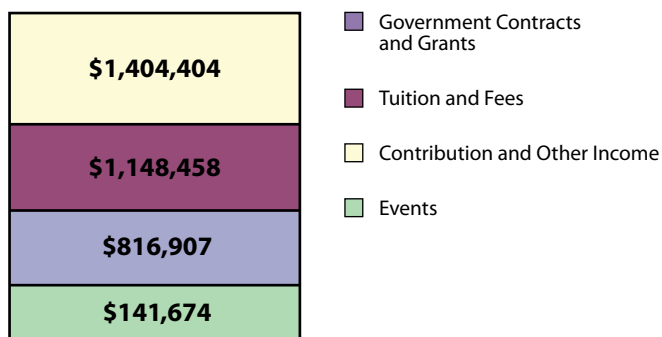
So dear friends, we are honored to have your trust. Please remember, **we rely on you in the same way that our families rely on us.**

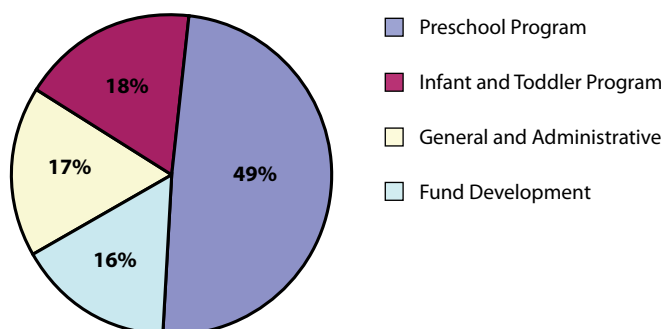
